Spiritual trip to the origins of Christianity

### SAT - DAY 1: FLIGHT TO LARNACA (LCN) AND TRANSFER TO KORMACIT VILLAGE

Arrival in Landing in Larnaca (LCN) airport – Welcome and pick up by our professional guide  
Private guided group transfer to KORMACIT Maronite village  
Tasting of bread, wine and cheese, check-in Kormacit Villas  
Overnight in Kormacit Villas

Our guide welcomes you at LARNACA (LCA) airport. Transfer to Kormacit, where we are welcomed with a light dinner: cheese, bread and wine. Afterwards we check in for the first night in the Kormacit Villas. Kormacit is the last village of the Maronite catholic community in Cyprus. The Maronites came with the crusaders in the middle ages and stayed on the island until today.

### SUN - DAY 2: ARAMAIC HOLY MASS AND “THE WILD WEST” OF NORTHERN CYPRUS

08:00 Aramaic Holy Mass in the Church of St. George in Kormacit  
09:00 Breakfast  
10:00 Departure to Güzelyurt  
10:30 St. Mamas and the archaeological museum  
12:00 Soli Ruins  
13:00 Traditional Lunch “Kleftiko” (lamb in the oven) in Lefke  
15:00 Palace of Vouni  
17:00 Return to Kormacit Village  
20:00 \*PREMIUM EXTENSION: Maronite Dinner with live music and all drinks included  
Overnight in Kormacit Villas

In the early morning we have the exclusive chance to take part in a holy mass in Aramaic, the language of Jesus in the Holy Land! After a breakfast we head for Güzelyurt, where we visit the Monastery of Saint Mamas, the patron saint of the tax evaders and the nearby archaeological museum with the “Golden Leaves”. In Soli we will visit the ruins of the ancient Byzantine church of Saint Auxibius and the Greek theatre. For lunch we continue to the city of Lefke, which is famous for a modern Islamic Saint, Sheik Nazim, who died only two years ago. The last sightseeing spot for today is Vouni Palace, a former Persian military camp with marvellous views to the Troodos Mountains and the western coastline before we return to our village.

**MON - DAY 3: SOUTHERN CYPRUS: TROODOS, OMODOS AND PAPHOS**

- 09:00 Departure after breakfast
- 10:00 Visit of Kakopetria and coffee break
- 11:30 Troodos View Point
- 12:30 \*PREMIUM EXTENSION: Lunch with typical Troodos trout
- 13:30 Visit of the Church of the Holy Cross and wine tasting in Omodos
- 15:30 Paphos – Visit of the mosaics and the Column of Saint Paul
- 17:00 Free time for exploring the Paphos harbour
- 18:00 Departure from Paphos
- 20:00 Arrival at Kormacit and Dinner  
Overnight in Kormacit Villas

We leave Kormacit after breakfast, heading for the Troodos Mountains. After crossing the inner Cypriot border at Bostanci checkpoint our first visit will be the mountain village of Kakopetria with its beautifully renovated old quarter. The lookout point next to the Mount Olympos is one of today's highlights. The southern slopes of the Troodos Mountains are famous for wine production. In the village of Omodos we will have a wine tasting and visit the Monastery of the Holy Cross. Our journey continues to Paphos, which was the first Christian city outside of the Holy Land. The highlights of Paphos are its mosaics of Dionysus's house and the Column of Saint Paul. After a guided tour you have some free time to explore the harbour before we drive back to Kormacit, where we have dinner.

**TUE - DAY 4: MARONITE VILLAGE LIFE AND HIGHLIGHTS OF KYRENIA**

- 09:00 Breakfast next to the bread oven
- 09:30 Cooking course and tastings
- 12:30 \*PREMIUM EXTENSION: Traditional Maronite Lunch
- 14:00 Transfer to Kyrenia
- 15:00 Visit of the Harbour Castle
- 16:30 Boat trip with dinner
- 20:00 Check in Dome Hotel  
Overnight in Kyrenia-Dome Hotel

The day starts with a breakfast next to Ema's mud brick oven. The Maronite women will explain about the techniques of baking bread, making Halloumi cheese and Carob cake. After the experience of preparing some of the Maronite Cypriot specialities we visit the ethnographical museum, before we leave the village and move on the scenic road of Sadrazamköy to the town of Kyrenia (Girne). In Kyrenia the visit of the impressive Harbour Castle is a must! The highlight of this day is a boat trip with dinner, to see the island from a totally different point of view and enjoy the crystal clear waters of the Mediterranean Sea. After coming back from the boat tour we check in at the seaside DOME Hotel next to the Venetian harbour.

**WED - DAY 5: WEDNESDAY MARKET AND EASY WALK**

- 09:15 Visit of the weekly Wednesday market
- 10:00 Transfer to the Five Finger Mountains and 4km walk to Antifonitis Monastery
- 12:30 Visit of Antifonitis Church and Picnic
- 14:00 Visit of Bellapais Monastery
- 15:00 Transfer back to Kyrenia, free time in the city
- 19:30 \*PREMIUM EXTENSION: Transfer to Klepini traditional tavern, private dinner with live music and all drinks included. This day will be accompanied by a professional photographer  
Overnight in Kyrenia-Dome Hotel

Wednesday is the day of the Weekly Market in Kyrenia. The market is a colourful mixture of fresh fruits and vegetables, homemade products from local farmers and a lot more. We continue with a transfer to the Five Finger Mountains (in Turkish: Besparmak), where we enjoy an easy walk to the Monastery of Antifonitis (alt. Antiphonitis). Antifonitis is famous for the colourful frescos dating back to the 12<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> centuries. After a picnic in the garden of the monastery we drive back towards Kyrenia. On the way back we visit the Bellapais Monastery, one of the most beautiful buildings from Lusignan period in Cyprus. In the afternoon we bring you back to our hotel and you have free time to explore the historic city of Kyrenia.

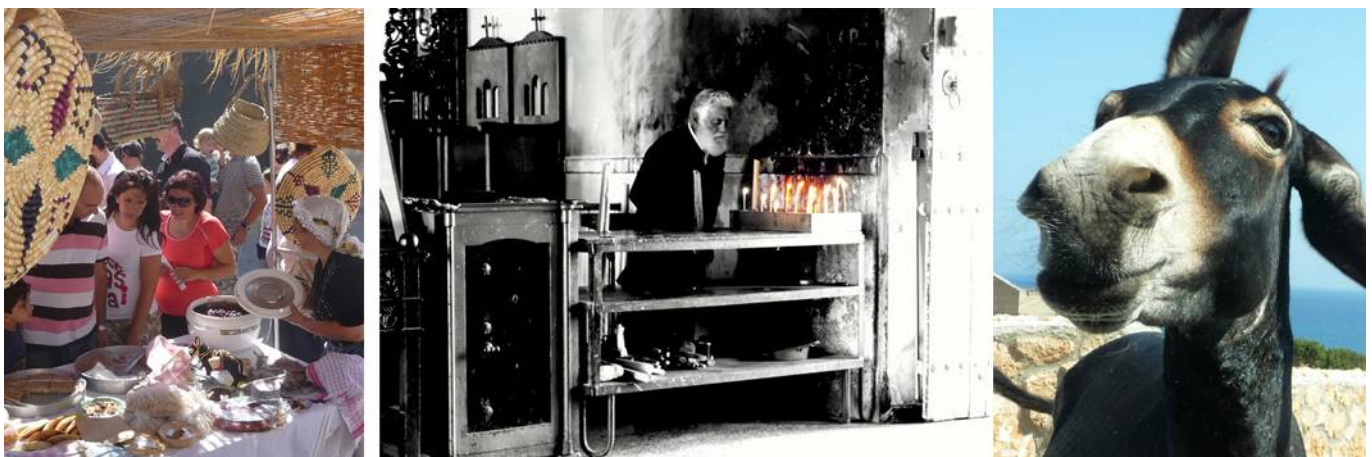

**THU - DAY 6: THE PRISTINE KARPAZ PENINSULA**

- 09:00 Departure from our hotel to the Karpaz peninsula
- 10:00 Workshop at traditional handicraft workshop in Büyükkonuk
- 13:00 Traditional lunch at our seaside Restaurant (Fish-Sea bream)
- 14:30 Visit of Apostolos Andreas Monastery and the Holy Well (at the moment the main church of Apostolos Andreas is in restoration)
- 15:30 Swimming break at the Golden Beach
- 19:00 Return to Dome Hotel

Overnight in Kyrenia-Dome Hotel

Today we are heading east towards Karpaz peninsula. Our first stop is Büyükkonuk, where we visit a traditional workshop that produces handmade goods from barley straw and reed. Here you have the chance to produce your unique souvenir with your name on it! We continue our journey to the tip of the peninsula to visit the Apostolos Andreas Monastery, well known amongst Cypriot and Orthodox Christians for its Holy Well. This water is said to be a remedy for eye and skin diseases! For lunch we have fresh Sea bream, grilled or from the oven. After a swimming break at the famous Golden Beach we return to Kyrenia.

**FRI - DAY 7: SAINT BARNABAS AND THE VENETIAN GLORY OF FAMAGUSTA**

- 09:00 Departure from Dome Hotel
- 09:30 Photo break at the Five Finger Rock
- 10:30 "Ghost city" of Varoscha
- 11:00 Visit of Old Town of Famagusta
- 12:30 Lunch at Salamis Beach
- 13:30 Visit of the Salamis Ruins and short swimming break
- 15:30 Visit of the Monastery of Saint Barnabas
- 17:00 Visit of an ostrich farm
- 19:00 \*PREMIUM EXTENSION: Traditional Tavern in the quarter of "Gönyeli" in Nicosia  
Overnight in Kyrenia-Dome Hotel

In the morning we cross the mountain range, having a photo break at the Five-Finger-Rock. The "ghost city" of Varoscha is one of the visible remains of the troubles started in 1963. Through the Venetian City Walls we drive into the old part of Famagusta. The Lala Mustafa Pascha mosque (former Saint Nicolas Cathedral) is one of the highlights during our walking city tour. After some free time in the city we continue to the Ruins of Salamis, here we have our lunch and a short swimming break. Salamis was also the birthplace of Saint Barnabas, who evangelized Cyprus together with Saint Paul. The Church of Saint Barnabas is the last cultural spot of today's program. Heading back westwards, we visit an ostrich farm where artworks are produced out of the huge eggs.

**SAT – DAY 8: LARNACA - SAINT LAZARUS**

- Check-out and Departure from Dome Hotel to Larnaca
- Visit of Larnaca City and Saint Lazarus Church
- Free time at leisure according to flight times
- Transfer to Airport (15 minutes)
- Return flight from Larnaca (LCN)

After breakfast and check out from DOME hotel we drive to Larnaca. The city of Larnaca hosts the Church of Saint Lazarus, one of the most important Orthodox churches in Cyprus, dating back to the 9<sup>th</sup> century. After some free time in the city we bring you to the airport, where we have to say good bye and güle güle!
